- 4) Windows and Patio Doors
 - a) Exterior- Aluminum or PVC Clad
 - b) Window Type- Slider or Double Hung
 - c) Patio Door- Sliding or Hinged
 - d) All of the above in these exterior colors ONLY:
 - 1) Andersen: Dark Bronze or Terratone
 - 2) Marvin: Bronze or Suede
- 5) Front Entrance Door and Deck/Garage Exterior Service Doors
 - a) Front Door and Service Doors Wood, Steel or Fiberglass
 - b) Choice of glass style in either door
 - c) Front door and Service door exterior color may be different but must be selected from the DOOR colors listed below.
 - d) All factory primed door surfaces must be painted.

6) Storm Doors

- a) Storm Doors Pre-finished Aluminum
- b) Choice of glass style
- c) Storm Doors may be any of the DOOR colors listed below

These 7 DOOR colors are approved by the Board of Directors for <u>ALL</u> homes in Cimarron Ponds. This includes Front entrance doors, Deck and Garage exterior service doors and Storm doors (excludes the interior garage service door). These colors match both Andersen and Larson pre-finished aluminum storm doors.

- a) Andersen: Dark Bronze, Terratone, Sandtone and Almond
- b) Larson: Woodland, Sandstone and Almond

Please contact a Board member for physical color samples and a Bar-code color formula sheet. The bar-code formula is for Sherwin-Williams Paints and will give you the correct color, base and sheen.

The color sample may be scanned by any other paint supplier.

7) Elevated or on grade **Wood Deck** approved colors are:

a) Andersen: Dark Bronze or Terratone

b) Marvin: Bronze or Suede

- 8) Elevated or on grade <u>Composite Material Deck</u> (Trex, Azek or other).
 - a) Any earthtone color which is compatible with the building color scheme.
 - b) The composite color sample must be Board approved.
